Versora Announces Progression Desktop for Windows, Offering Migration to Windows Vista

New Progression Desktop for Windows 3.0 capabilities includes 2000/XP to Vista migration, migration to Windows Mail & Office 2007, and access to source code for ease of integration.

Santa Barbara, CA – December 4, 2006 – Versora announced today Progression Desktop for Windows 3.0, which includes new functionality and application support for the automated desktop migration tool.

In addition to the functionality found in Progression Desktop for Windows 2.5 (which migrates data, documents, system and user settings between Windows desktops), Progression Desktop 3.0 supports migrating between various applications. Some examples are: Microsoft Office and OpenOffice.org, AOL Instant Messenger and GAIM, Microsoft Outlook, Outlook Express, Eudora and Mozilla Thunderbird.

Progression Desktop 3.0 is the only personality migration tool available offering such widespread platform support. Additionally, it is the only tool that supports migrating to popular open source applications running on Windows.

“Progression Desktop for Windows 3.0 will save a technician 7 hours of time per computer for a migration”, notes Versora VP Product Management Matthew Warne. “Not only do we support all of Microsoft’s core desktop applications, we also support moving between other popular vendor applications such as IE and Firefox or Eudora and Windows Mail (Outlook Express).”

Progression Desktop for Windows 3.0 yields dramatic time and cost savings for desktop migrations via an easy to use “Next-Next-Finished” wizard interface. Migrations can also be fully automated from a command line to allow integration with third party system management tools such as Microsoft Systems Management Software or Novell ZENworks.

Progression Desktop for Windows is distributed under an Enterprise Source License (ESL) which allows the administrator the option of viewing and modifying the source code to meet any of the organization's specific needs. The ESL also gives the organization control over future development of the code to avoid lock-in to a specific vendor.
